

Establishment of Jakarta representative office

Kurimoto, Ltd. (head office: Nishi-ku, Osaka, President: Hideaki Fukui) established a representative office on October 1, 2015 in Jakarta, Indonesia, to collect information for the purpose of business expansion in the country. Of the nations in the growing ASEAN market, Indonesia is projected to show especially robust growth in the coming years.

The vision outlined in the Kurimoto Group's Three-Year Mid-Term Business Plan, formulated in 2015, is of "a company that can respond to the demands of an international society," and expanding our business overseas is a cornerstone of our business strategy. Indonesia, where we have just established a representative office, is home to approximately 250 million people, around 40% of the ASEAN region's population of 620 million. Since a democratic government was formed in 2004, the country has seen steady economic growth, and significant demand is projected for building of infrastructure (roads, railways, ports, airports, electrical, water and sewage systems, etc.) as well as new manufacturing equipment and updating or expansion of existing equipment, notably in the automotive, chemical, and food processing sectors. At Kurimoto, with "social infrastructure" and "industrial equipment" as our core business domains, we view Indonesia as one of the most crucial markets going forward, and we are placing a high priority on data collection and market surveys aimed at strengthening our presence there.
